Call to order at 7:37 p.m. by Tim Dry.

Treasurer's Report

Rich Nalder had team itemizations for all fall teams. The CVSC \$15 per player fee has been deducted from each team account. The CVSC fee is \$15 per player for first season of play and \$10 per player for second season of play (for August 2007-July 2008.)

GBYSL Policy on Ejections

GBYSL is cracking down on coach and parent conduct at the games. If a coach disagrees and argues with the referee, the coach may be suspended for a minimum of two games. Decisions are being made more quickly this season (no meetings to discuss the problem.) GBYSL will get the referees incident report and make a decision. Coaches need to be a good role model for the players and the parents. Club is also being stricter about parent behavior. Poor parental behavior can result in the parent being ejected from the game, the referee asking the coach to get the parent under control, or the coach being suspended.

There are several ways that a coach can handle a dispute with a referee:

1. Speak to the referee in a respectful and non-threatening manner about the issue.
2. Submit a report about the issue to GBYSL.

Tryouts for Spring 2008

GBYSL tryout dates are Nov. 11 through Nov. 25.

Due to the Thanksgiving holiday, CVSC will hold tryouts during the first week of this period. CVSC will get lighted fields for Mon., Nov. 12 thru Thur., Nov. 15 and Sat., Nov. 17. Coaches can choose two of those dates to hold tryouts for their teams. Tim Dry will coordinate field use. Jim Talia will contact Parks and Rec. Dept. to reserve fields.

Teams may choose to hold tryouts if they want to add players. However, teams are not required to hold tryouts. Fall teams can add players or replace players who choice not to continue for the spring season. Teams cannot drop current players who wish to remain on the team.

New teams for the spring 2008 season will want to hold tryouts. This applies mainly to older teams (high school age.) High school players cannot be recruited for spring teams until the high school season has ended. Coaches for new spring teams need to submit a coaching application to CVSC. Applications are available online at the CVSC website.

CVSC will advertise tryout dates along with a list of the teams holding tryouts. Ideas for advertising were discussed: newspaper calendars, newspaper ads (Record Courier and Nevada Appeal), fliers sent to schools, fliers posted at local businesses and gyms, fliers distributed to AYSO All-Star coaches and teams.

Open to the floor for questions and discussion

A rash of thefts has occurred at the South Valleys fields in Reno. Thefts are smash and grab type, occur during soccer games, happen most often at the upper, dirt parking lot. Coaches are asked to inform parents about these thefts.

CVSC Logo Design Contest- Tim will put together a flier; no specific time for contest has been chosen.

Jim Talia will start attending the GBYSL meetings to represent CVSC. Tim Dry also attends when he is available.

CVSC Equipment Manager Position is vacant. Rich Nalder mentioned that CVSC equipment and AYSO equipment is mixed up in the field boxes. He asked if anyone has an itemized list of equipment owned by CVSC. Tim Dry does not think there is such a list or if anyone would know which items are owned by which group.

Rich Nalder asked if CVSC has any National "D" licensed coaches. There are not any current fall coaches with this license.

Tim Dry asked if there have been any issues with the field at Pinion Hills Elementary School. Most comments have been positive.

Rene Hoogendijk asked if fields are available for scrimmages after the season has ended. Fields will not be lined after the last season games; however, the goals will remain up until late November.
