GBYSL Report

1. USYSNV has employed a third party to perform background checks on all coaches, team managers, board members, etc. Every team official will be required to fill out the online form that will kick off the background check. The cost for the background check is \$6, which can be paid online or by submitting a check via US Mail. In order to avoid a logjam, they have distributed the processing over the next 9 months based on the first initial of your last name. Here is the schedule:

Tim Dry recommends that CVSC reimburse this expense for those team officials that request to be reimbursed. Anyone requesting reimbursement should submit a receipt to the club.

Jim Talia made a motion to approve reimbursement of the \$6 background check fee. Second by Deanna Abbott. Motion approved.

2. In order to promote consistency, every team will be issued one game ball this year. You will be responsible for providing these game balls to the official when requested. You will also be financially responsible for replacing the balls if they are lost.

3. Make sure your team referees are certified and ready to work this season when called upon. If you do not have a certified referee for every game, your team will still play. However your team will have to forfeit the game in the league standings. Coaches cannot referee.

4. U10, U11, and U12 teams will play some games with teams from the AYSO Toiyabe League. Games will not count in the GBYSL standings. Games will be played with the number of players that GBYSL teams typically play as long as the Toiyabe team has enough players available.

Logo Design Contest

There were five submissions for the logo contest. Logos will be judged later. Club would like to create patches of the logo to use in future seasons.

Jog-A-Thon

Jog-a-thon had a good turnout (approximately 70 players participated) and was well run. CVSC commends the teams that participated. It was noted that some teams did not have any players or coaches in attendance and that was disappointing. A suggestion for future CVSC fundraisers is that the club clarifies why they need to raise money and explain how the money will be used.

There may be some conflicts, i.e. Lampe – for special event, CVMS – for track meets.
